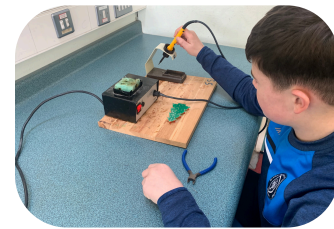
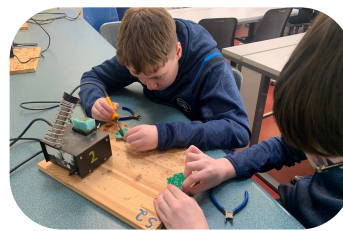

Year 10 Gardening

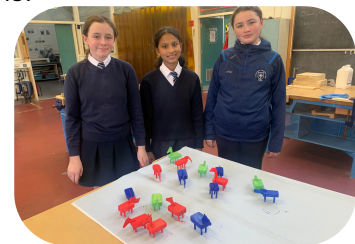
As part of ongoing work on environmental awareness and sustainability, Year 10 pupils took part in a practical gardening session in the school grounds with Emmett Brogan, Climate Change Officer from Fermanagh and Omagh District Council. 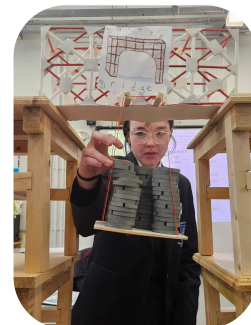
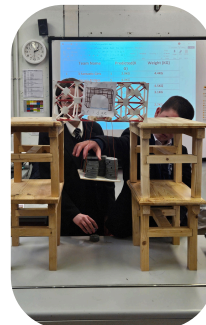
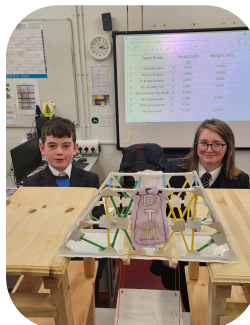
Year 9 STEM: Bridge Challenge -

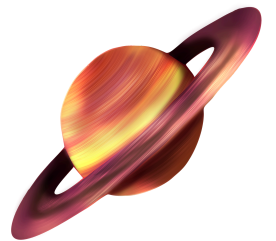
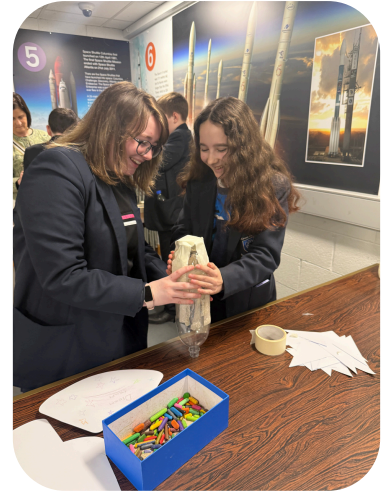
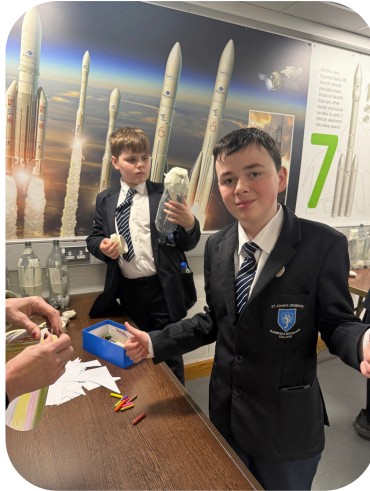
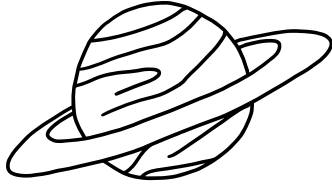
Choir

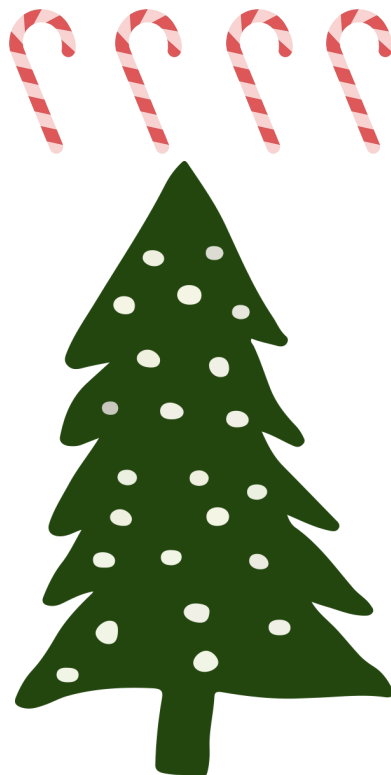


We are delighted to announce our grand total for 'Digg Deep for Kids'. 🎅 was an amazing....
